



## Donations Policy

### 1. Donations

- 1.1 Donations are defined as monetary or equipment gifts that are given to Parafed Wellington with no obligation of public recognition by Parafed Wellington. Parafed Wellington may solicit donations from family, friends, members or the community at large. Donations can be recorded as tax-deductible, but additional paperwork is required.
- 1.2 Where a gift or donation is received for a specific purpose from a donor, no matter what the dollar value, this shall be disclosed to the Committee and confirmed before it is accepted. Acceptance for transfer to an alternative purpose, if the specific purpose cannot be undertaken for some reason, should be sought from donor at the time of receipt.
- 1.3 If the donation is equipment, acceptance should be sought from donor at the time of receipt of equipment for parafed Wellington to sell, donate or dispose of equipment if it is not required by Parafed Wellington.
- 1.4 If the donor cannot approve any changes post-donation, the Parafed Wellington committee shall have the right to reallocate the donation.
